Dr. Monheit is clinical associate professor in the department of dermatology and ophthalmology at the University of Alabama at Birmingham Medical Center. He is a fellow of The American Academy of Dermatology, The American Society for Dermatologic Surgery, The American Association of Liposuction Surgeons, American Association of Hair Restoration Surgeons, American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery and American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, among others. He was President of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery 2001 and serves on the board of directors. He is Past-President of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery and also serves on its Board of Directors. He is a member of the International Society for Dermatologic Surgery, the Skin Cancer Foundation and the Leader's Society of the Dermatology Foundation. He is a fellow of the American College of Mohs Micrographic Surgery and Cutaneous Oncology and has served on its board of directors. Dr. Monheit is listed in Best Doctors in America 1995, 1998, 2000 and 2002, Best Doctors in Southeastern United States 1997 and received Recognition for Development of Programming from the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery in 1998 and 1999. Dr. Monheit also serves on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Dermatologic Surgery*, *Journal of Cosmetic Surgery* and *Cosmetic Dermatology*, and is a regular contributor to the Dermatologic literature. He is board-certified by the American Board of Dermatology and the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery. He lectures nationally and internationally and has contributed over 40 journal articles and numerous book chapters to the medical literature. Dr. Monheit has done extensive clinical research into fillers and toxins. His present clinical research interests include:

- photoaging skin and treatment with cosmoceutical agents, peels, lasers and dermabrasion
- filling agents for aging skin and scarring conditions
- evaluation of photoaging skin
